## This is A Few Forgotten Women Story



This story was written, in April 2024, as one of a series resulting from the 'A Few Forgotten Women Friday' collaborative research project, investigating the lives of women staff and female patients associated with the Fleming Memorial Children's Hospital, Jesmond, Northumberland.

## **Lilian Bells's Story**

Lilian Bell was born in 1890 in Newcastle to William Smith Bell and Ursula Barlow.

William and Ursula appear on the 1891 Census<sup>1</sup> but Lilian does not appear on the census with them as she is in Fleming Memorial Children's Hospital. The family is living at 20 Duke Street, Westgate, Newcastle Upon Tyne. William and Ursula had one son living with them called William S Bell who was listed as being 3 years old and a daughter named Eleanor aged 2.

William Smith Bell and Ursula Barlow married in Gateshead in 1887<sup>2</sup>

Lilian appears back with them on the 1901 Census<sup>3</sup> at 16 Pallister Street, South Shields with William S Bell aged 36 and he was a Hairdresser born in Newcastle, and Ursula was born in Northumberland. They had 6 children at

this point Lilian and her brothers William, Harry and Lancelot and her sisters Eleanor and Alice.

The family then appear on the 1911 Census in 8 Maxwell Street, South Shields

Lilian's father William Smith Bell had died by then and her mother was listed as a widow. He died in 1903 at the age of only 38.4

Lilian was living with her sisters Eleanor and Alice and her brothers Henry and Lancelot and was listed as being a Domestic Servant. It is crossed out but says that William and Ursula were married 25 years and had 9 children, 6 living and 3 that had died.

Lilian married on 18<sup>th</sup> September 1912 at St Hilda's Church<sup>5</sup>, South Shields to Thomas Arthur Birkett.

She had a daughter Edith L Birkett who was born in 1913<sup>6</sup> and who sadly died in the same quarter in 1913<sup>7</sup>

Lilian sadly died herself on 13<sup>th</sup> December 1913<sup>8</sup> at 6 Broderick Street, South Shields of Cardiac Vascular disease and her husband Thomas Arthur Birkett was the informant.
